

Facts about the MSC in Coaching and Development

The Postgraduate programme

- It takes 3 years to complete the programme. It is divided into 3 levels, Certificate, Diploma and Masters. The student can choose 1, 2 or to participate in all 3 years. Every level will give the student a university degree, which will prove the high level of commitment, engagement and responsibility for performance.
- Portsmouth University is engaged in all parts of the programme, and have dedicated their own programme responsible to qualify and secure the academic rigor and quality.
- The programme training is divided into modules, 6 in total equal 12 days of module training and tutoring. Each module is 2 days from 9.00 am to 18.00 PM. Between each module are 6-7 weeks for working on your projects and coaching portfolio and learning reflecting log.
- Each level will only take a max. of 18 students, and for each module there will be two trainers and 1 or two assistants, to support the student and the group.
- There are 3 working based projects in regard to module 2, 4 and 5. The student pick their own project objective related to coaching practice in a company or organisation. The research project bring together practice and academia delivering a high level paper from which leaders can be recommended new ways of working and increasing performance.
- In addition to the academic projects each student will deliver 3 coaching processes which will be reported in a coaching log (portfolio) combined with a learning reflexion log on own development as a coach. This project will be delivered in the end of year one, and count for 25% of the Diploma level work.
- All working based learning projects are being graded by external tutors, the programme directors and the university, so in all 3 different quality assurance parties grading your academic work. Portsmouth University will make sure each piece of work stand the quality assurance of any leading university in the world.
- Each student will have their own Mentor, which they find themselves, a student coach, an assigned programme director for direct support, a students advisor and further support from the Danish Coaching Institute. A student network will also be in place.
- There are a great deal of focus on student coaching practice. This is to make sure that the student understand the practice of coaching and the practice of research making the combination a very solid and reliable craftsmanship. The perspectives of being a coach, being coached and observing coaching and researching bring the students knowledge, understanding and usability to a high level.

Career and Coach delivery Opportunities

- A coach holding a Masters i Coaching & Development will be in a position to develop the human resources and support structures that encourage responsibility and ownership for performance and results.
- This programme focus on development. Individual, team and organisation development. It will support the student in working at various levels and in regard to various challenges and goals.
- The students can use this to work as a coach in practice and as a coaching consultants delivering reports in which companies and organisations can receive high quality research recommending areas of improvement and spotting key performance.
- In the coaching role and during the modules each student will gain insight and clarity about their own role as a coach and how they can use in a daily practice. Working with coaching practice, team development, Emotional Development and Systemic Leadership you will gain a broad and a focused training.
- The contense of this programme bring managers and leaders the ability understand the nature of human beings in a work, career and life setting. People are they key to success and therefore more leaders and managers need coaching skill and practice to unlock the human potential and talents.
- It bring the undertanding to build structures, communication and porcesses that support people to deliver higher quality performance and results.
- Many companies and organisations ask for qualified and high level coaches to become sparring partners for ther senior executives, valuable specialits and talents. In a fast paced working day, no ressources are in place to support the individual and team besides the leader. Many ask external coaches for their expertise to get more and better performance, work/life balance and career satisfaction.
